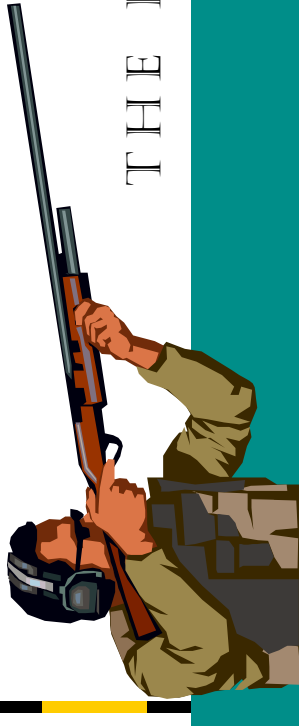

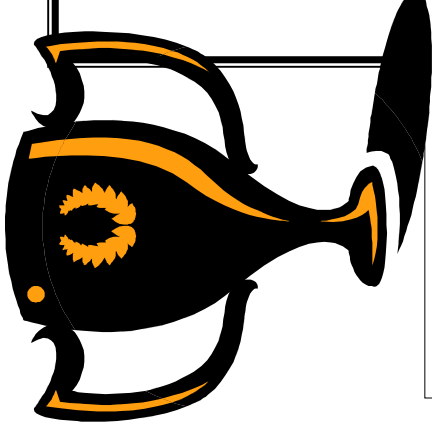

## Sportsman of the Year Award

Last year, our board felt we had been amiss in recognizing members that have made significant contributions to our club. Twenty-three years ago, Joe Puryear and his close friend, Lloyd Fredrick, had a vision to establish a sportsman club here in Fairfield Glade. Both Joe and Lloyd set out in mid-1985 to find a suitable site for trap, skeet, rifle and pistol ranges. It took them two years to find it, but on July 27, 1987, Joe and Lloyd met with 30 other interested sportsmen to form our club. Joe served as president from 1987 thru 1989 and again in 1992. Lloyd served in different officer positions as vice-president, secretary and treasurer from 1987 to 1994. Lloyd passed away in January 1995.

For 2008 a slate of candidates was presented to the Directors at the annual election meeting, and Carl "Pete" Brennan was chosen by a majority of the board members voting.

## Combination Ranges are Nearly Complete

Work is proceeding well with our two new combined trap/skeet fields – fields 5 and 6. The three skeet houses and one trap house were constructed in late summer 2007 and final grading and the installation of Trap machines on Field six was completed. We also put in a new driveway and parking area.

A set of fences was constructed to isolate the two Skeet Fields from each other and from the other Trap fields. The use of Field #5 began in late 2007 and continues today.

In December 2007, the last set of Machinery arrived for field #6 and was installed. Doug Server's crew had previously installed electrical equipment, and the field will be ready for use in early 2008.

This will complete our project to expand and re-locate our Skeet fields.
